Citizen UK's Living Wage for Care Workers Charter. Rev Dr Joseph Cortis, Coordinator for Caritas Leeds, is inviting parishioners to sign an open letter from faith and civic leaders in support of the real Living Wage for care workers: This can be found at <https://actionnetwork.org/forms/sign-our-living-wage-for->

careworker-charter. This letter has already been signed by many faith leaders across the country.

On 2nd July Leeds Citizens organised a day of action in support of this campaign, which included a socially distanced gathering of 74 faith and community leaders at Sunnyview House in Beeston. The government is being asked to provide £1.4 billion in funding to guarantee all care workers delivering any form of publicly funded care will be paid at least the real Living Wage of £9.30/hr (£10.75 in London).

Registering for the celebration of Mass.

In order to attend Mass **a place has to be booked** and we have to keep a record of who attends Mass together with their contact details for 21 days which would be used by “Track and Trace” if required. These details will be taken at the time of booking. Bookings should preferably be made through the website (www.stcolumbascatholicchurch.com). Those without internet access should ring Fr Michael on 361682 or Marina Armstrong on 07768 875708 being careful to leave their name and phone number and the Mass they wish to attend in any message. The booking system needs to be reasonably flexible to reflect the different sized groups in which parishioners come to church and so each ticket refers to a space which includes social distance -**one** ticket will accommodate a **single person or a couple**; **two** tickets will accommodate a **family group**. There is no need to reserve more than two tickets to reserve an appropriate space for your family.

Parishioners **should not attend** Mass if they have Covid symptoms or are particularly vulnerable.

Volunteers as stewards/sanitizers. We need to build up the number of those available for helping as stewards/sanitizers. As Mass resumes duties will be wrapped around the Mass you are attending, and the commitment will involve arriving early for stewarding duties and remaining after Mass to sanitize the areas that have in use.
