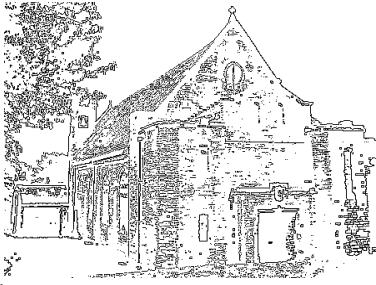

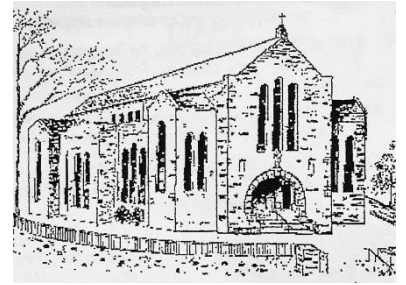

Financial Accounts. Ordinarily the accounts for the last financial year would have been presented at an Open Parish meeting in June and then made available to all parishioners. Fr Michael will present these accounts next Sunday, presenting St Malachy's accounts at the 6.30pm and 9.00am Masses and St Columba's at the 11.00am Mass.
